### **Year 4 Christmas Production of The Inn-Spectors**

We are pleased to announce that this year, Year 4 will be showing the Christmas Nativity 'The Inn-Spectors', which we will begin to rehearse straight after our return from Calshot.

This will take place on **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> December at 2:00pm and again at 6.00pm**. All our rehearsals leading up to these performances will be held within the school day, making valuable contributions to the music curriculum, as well as providing the children their time to shine. However, we would like to see all our children with reading parts, practising and learning their lines at home to aid with rehearsals in school. A copy of their scripts have been sent home in their bags to help them. As you can see, one of our performances will be after school hours, this is designed to ensure that our parents and carers, who would be unable to make the afternoon session due to work commitments or other, are also able to enjoy their child's efforts. Please could we ask you to bring your child **back to school at 5:30pm** that day, so that we can get ready for our early evening performance. Collection from the school office, for those parents and carers not attending the early evening show, will be 6:45pm.

Each class has been assigned group roles for costumes, and we are hoping to enlist your help with these if possible. There is no expectation to buy anything new, please use clothing that you have at home.

**4P are wise men:** They will need to wear Bethlehem Bling! (Patterned/striped fabric/dressing gown for robes, tissue paper/plastic jewels, cardboard crown).

**4W are shepherds:** They will need to wear a full length outfit in neutral colours. (Brown bed sheet/pillow case/plain dressing gown for robes, tea towel/neutral fabric and ribbon for headwear, a rope/fabric belt).

**4F are angels:** They will need to wear a white full-length outfit with halo but please no wings. (White bed sheet/long white t-shirt, tinsel belt, tinsel and wire halo. Please ensure the children have some light coloured leggings or trousers underneath their outfit).

Children who have speaking parts will be informed individually as to what they should wear.
