**Sports Day – Springfield Secondary School
Monday 17th June 2024**

I am pleased to invite you to our annual sports event which is being held at Springfield Secondary School on Monday 17th June 2024.

Children will be competing in a series of activities including sprinting, sack/skipping, hockey/football slalom, egg and spoon, long jump, vortex ball throw and relay. A map of these activities is provided below which details the order of the events and shows where they will be staged.

In the event of rain, unfortunately we will be unable to continue with proceedings and Springfield will make a decision about this in the morning and let us know. We will provide you with an email by 8.45am if the event is cancelled. Please ensure the office has your up to date contact details.

We will be walking to Springfield from Solent Junior School as soon possible once classes have been registered etc. In order to ensure we have an adequate ratio of adults to children so that we can walk the children safely, we are seeking volunteers to help walk us there and back. Volunteers will need to be available to walk both ways and be able to arrive at Solent for the start of the school day. Please indicate on the jot form link, by Friday 7th June, if you are able to support with this. If your support is required, we will contact you by Monday 10th June to take up your offer of help.

Sports Day will commence at 9:15am with an approximate finish time of 12:00 noon. As the children eat their lunch in the playground when they get back, there are special meal arrangements for this day. The school dinner options will be a Ham or Cheese Sub with a shortbread biscuit and fruit, alternatively your child may bring a home packed lunch. Please order this in advance using the school gateway app.

If you are coming to watch your child, please do not arrive at Springfield before 9:05am. Entry is through the gate on Grove Road only, which will take you directly onto the field. Springfield will not allow access through any other entrance as it is imperative that their site remains safe for their students. Please see the attached map for details.

On the day, children will need to come to school dressed in their P.E kit. Suitable footwear is essential, so please ensure children wear trainers rather than plimsolls, as the nature of some of the events will require strong, stable footwear.

Adequate hydration is also essential so that children enjoy the event fully; therefore please provide children with a clearly-labelled water bottle. It will be the children's responsibility to look after this during the events. It is also essential that children bring a sunhat and that sun cream is applied before leaving home in the hope of sunny weather!
